- § Willing to learn to be a helper without dominating, controlling or leading
- § A willingness to develop a positive relationship with the trainer(s)

Helpers must be available days, evenings and weekends. You need to be flexible in your personal or work schedule.

Helpers must commit to the project and performing the role of a Helper for at least one year. Interviews for Helpers will take place in January in your community. Attendance at the following Train the Trainer dates are mandatory.
